

Tea, Rubber and Coconut Estates (Control of Fragmentation) Board

Notice to the Public !

Tea, Rubber and Coconut Estates (Control of Fragmentation) Act, No. 02 of 1958, as amended by the Tea, Rubber and Coconut Estates (Control of Fragmentation) (Amendment) Act, No. 20 of 2005, has been introduced with the objective of minimizing the impact on the national economy from the fragmentation of tea, rubber, and coconut Estate.

Within the existing legal framework, the consent of the Tea, Rubber and Coconut Estates (Control of Fragmentation) Board shall be obtained to transfer the ownership of coconut Estate not less than 04 hectares in extent and tea and rubber Estate not less than 20 hectares in extent and the transfers made without consent of the Board shall be deemed to be null and void in terms of the provisions of the Act.

However, as the lands under tea, coconut, and rubber plantations are currently being fragmented and existing plantations are being removed for various projects without any plan, the requirement to amend existing legislations and safeguard the plantations has emerged.
